Wynfield Forest is divided into seven “Villages,” with volunteers (known as “Village Reps”) serving to welcome new neighbors and distribute the newsletters, directories, pool passes, etc. Their names and phone numbers are listed in the front of the Wynfield Forest directory, which is published once a year (usually around the beginning of the new year. The directory includes homeowners’ names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses.
